

The Dane County Farmers Market is offering two (2) scholarships to students studying agriculture or any agriculture related subject area. Students enrolled in two or four year programs are eligible to apply. Scholarship recipients will receive a \$1100.00 scholarship. The scholarship will be payable, toward tuition, to the school the recipient is attending-one half in the fall semester, and one half in the spring semester. Payment of the scholarship each semester will be contingent on the continuing school eligibility criteria. The completed application must be received by the scholarship committee by June 30, 2017. Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than August 15, 2017.

Requirements

Recipient should be planning on choosing a major or a minor in an Agricultural science  
Recipient must have a minimum of 30 college credits.  
Recipient should have at least one quarter or semester remaining following the fall term 2017.  
Recipient should have a minimum 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.  
Demonstrated interest or experience in local food production or markets is preferred.  
Applications must be received by June 30, 2017.  
Only undergraduate students are eligible to apply.

Statement of purpose

On a separate sheet of paper or email, state why you are interested in a career in agriculture. Describe your career goals and how a scholarship will help you learn. Include your interest and work or study related to agriculture.

College transcripts:

Please include a copy of your official college transcript.

Recommendation letters:

Three letters of recommendation, including one from an academic adviser or instructor, explaining your interest in agriculture.  
Application, supporting materials and letters of recommendation should be received by June 30, 2017.
